Intervals Recognition (visual): 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th. Melodic & Harmonic

Composers: Bach, Beethoven, Clementi, Haydn, Handel, Kabalevsky, Mozart, (Know Nationality)

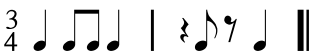
Ear Training: Identify Major and minor chords, Major & minor Pentascales. Notes ascending, descending, or repeated.

Identify Notes: Middle C to  C (3rd Space),  C (2nd Space) to Middle C

Spell & Recognize White Key Major Triads, Root Position

Intervals Recognition (visual), Melodic & Harmonic. Major, minor or Perfect. 2nd to 8va.

Ear Training: Major, minor, diminished, and augmented chords, Intervals: 2nd through 8va.

Key Signatures: All Major and minor

Spell *All* Major Scales and Minor Scales up to 4# & 4b, Natural, Harmonic, Melodic

Spell & Identify White Key Major Triads: Root Position, 1st Inversion, 2nd Inversion

Musical Eras: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionist, Contemporary (know chronological order)

Composers: Identify Nationality & Musical era
